Main function: Coordinating the Research component of the new regional YIP Programme

Responsibilities:

1. Project management

- Develops, leads and manages the Research component of the project

2. Research oversight

- Provide coordination and support to ensure the implementation of the Youth Integrity Survey
- Trains interviewers with sufficient skills needed for the Survey

3. Advocacy

- Provides thorough research finding to be used for advocacy

4. Youth mobilization

- Assist in the coordination of activities related to youth integrity promotion, such as workshops, press conferences, trainings or public appearances
- Assist in the facilitation of the development of a youth volunteer network (organize the network, manage its volunteers and support its activities)
- Monitor new developments related to youth integrity mobilization in the country

5. Communication

- Provide Project research results for external purposes
- Work with other relevant organizations, individuals or networks on relevant project matters.
