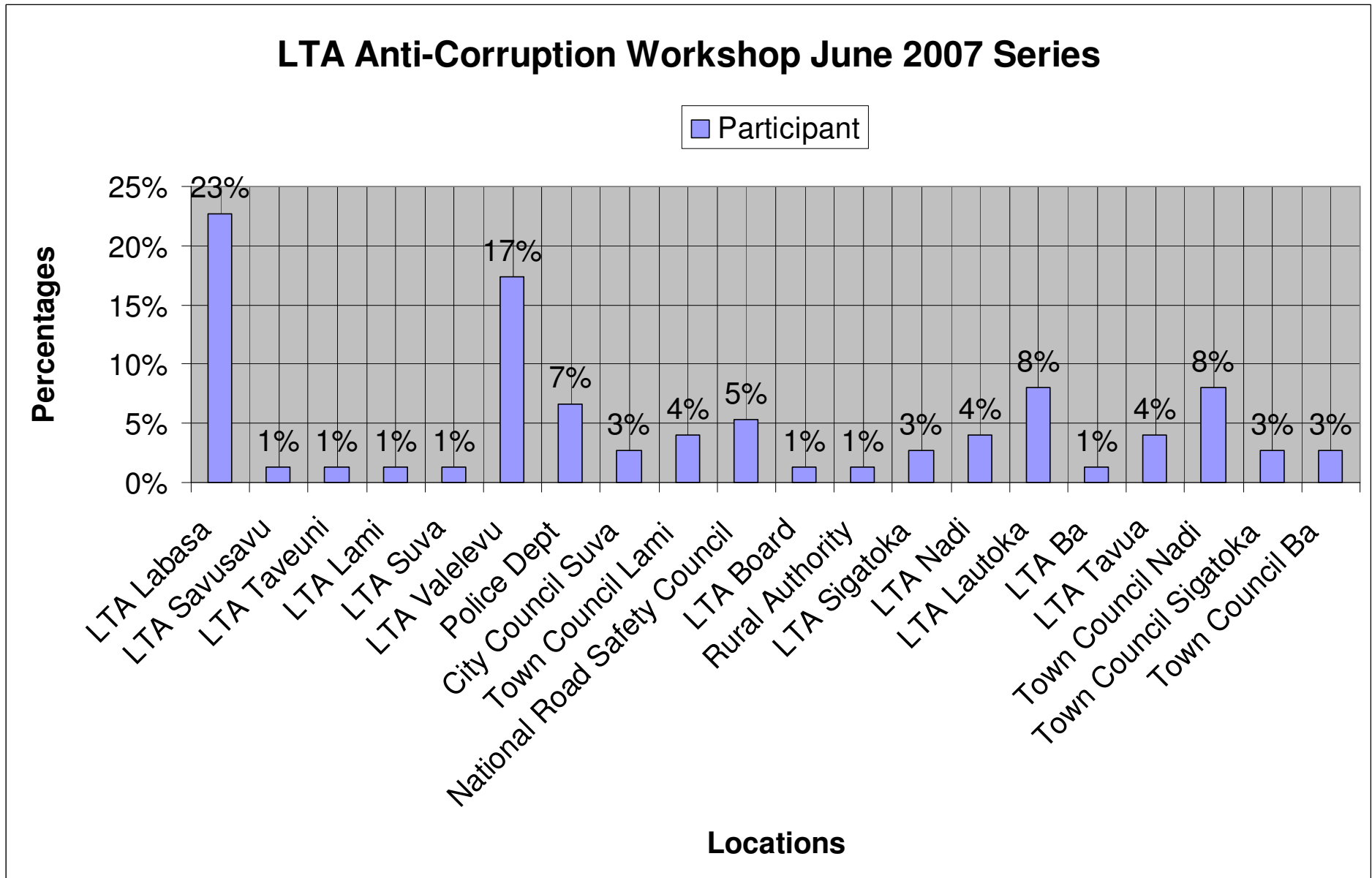
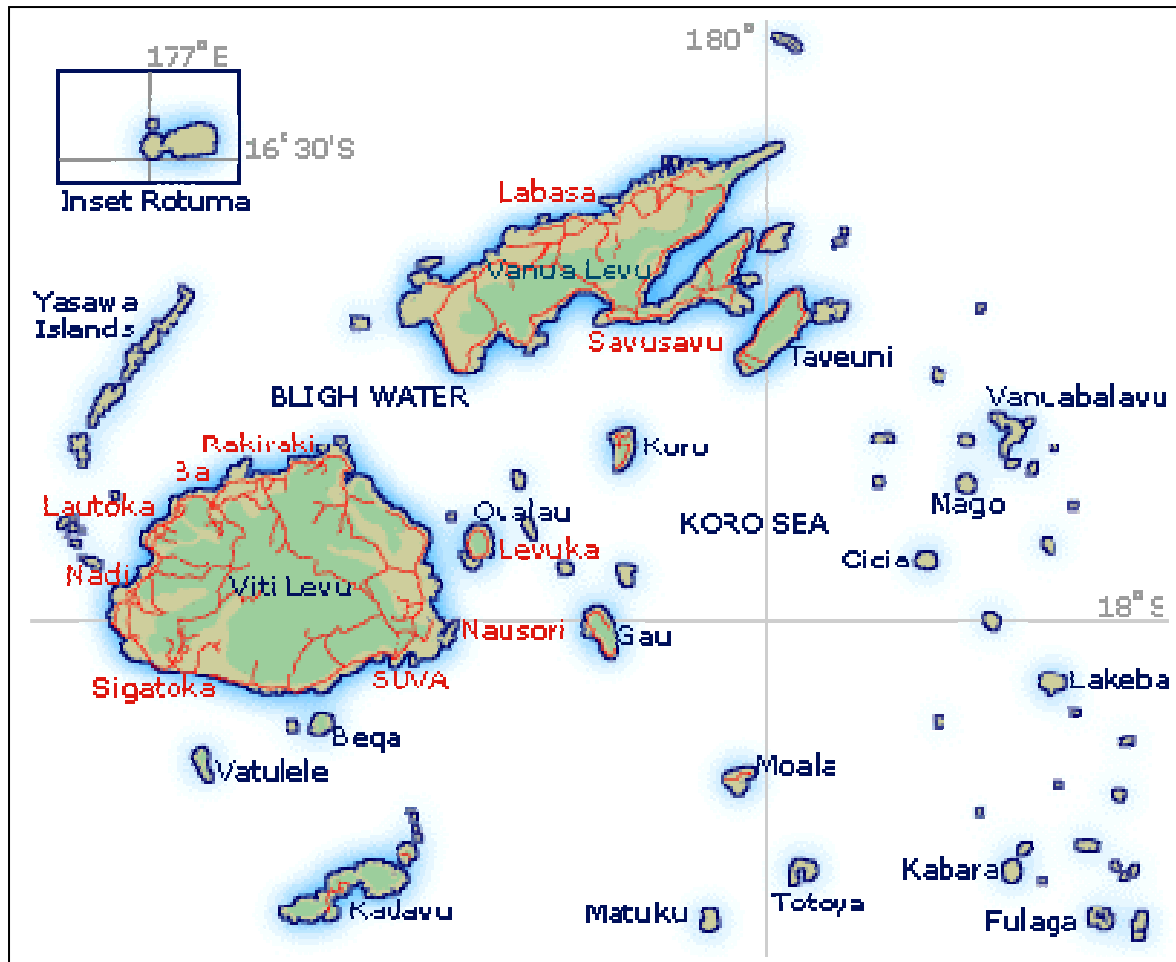

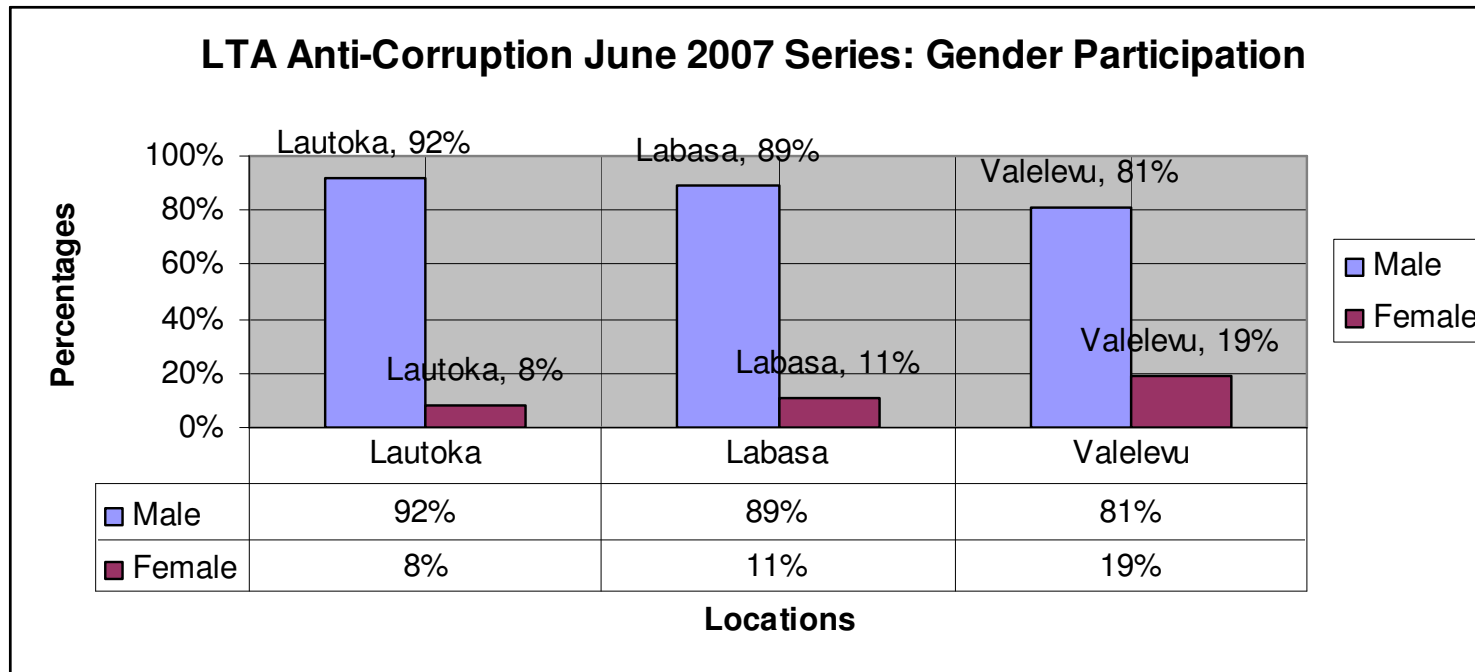
Participant came from all the main regions of the main islands of Fiji namely Viti Levu, Vanua Levu and Taveuni. This makes the spread of the message quite extensive. If we assumed that the workshop participants would move on to talk about corruption to families (5) and workmates (7) on a ratio of 1:12 then the estimate is that a total of say (75x12=900) people have had the opportunity to share the information on Anti-Corruption and integrity due to the mounting of this workshop, spread all over the Fiji group.

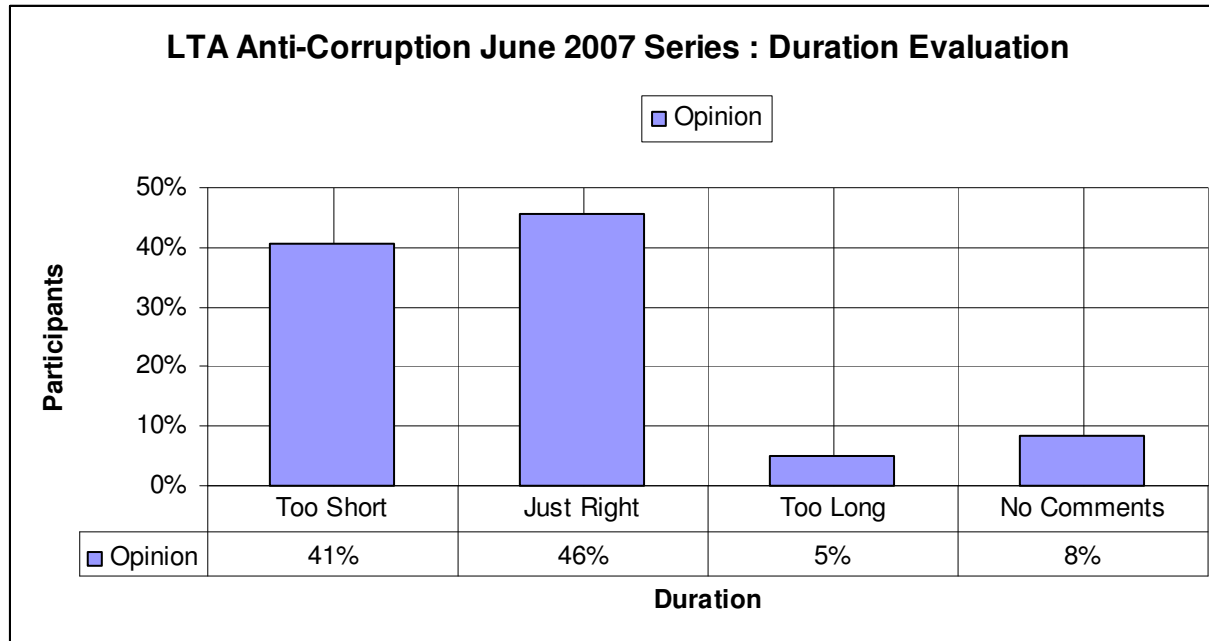
Graphically this can be shown as follows:

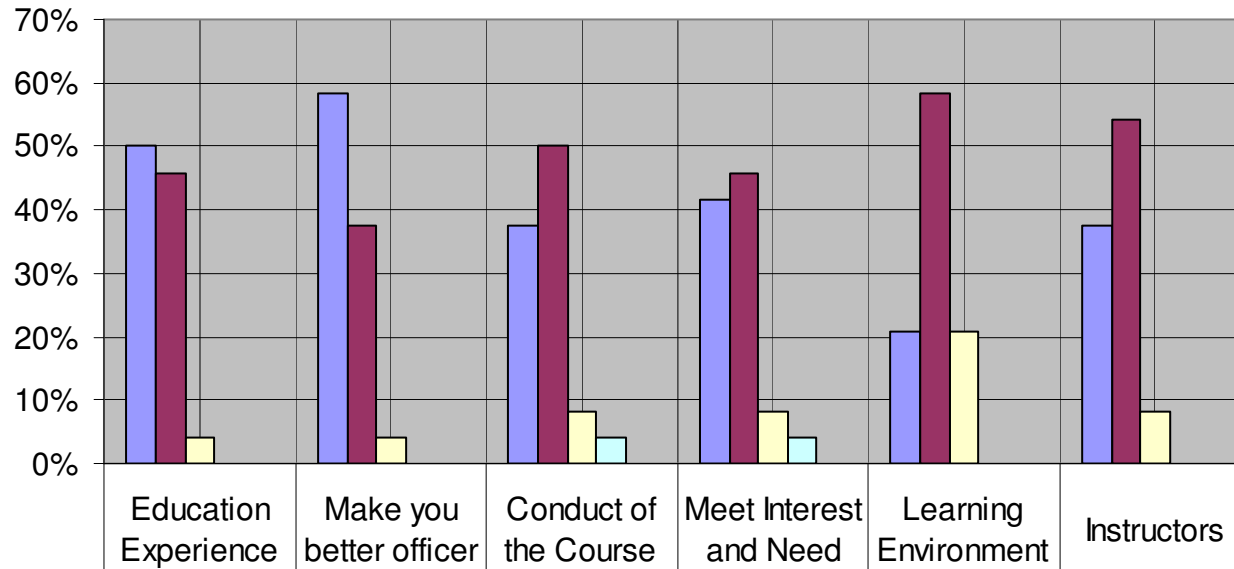

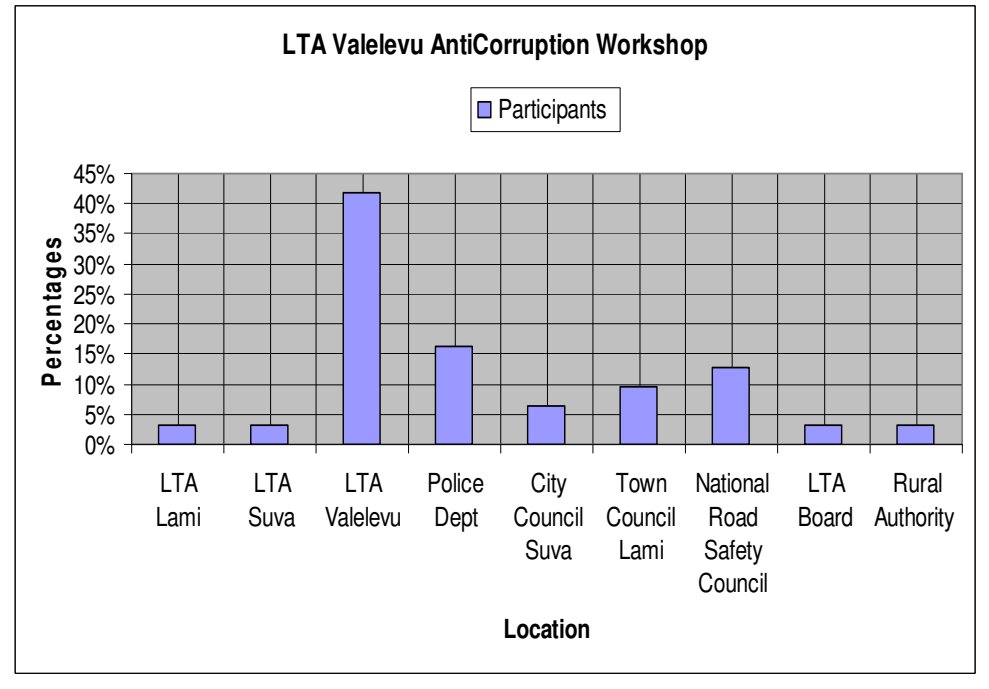
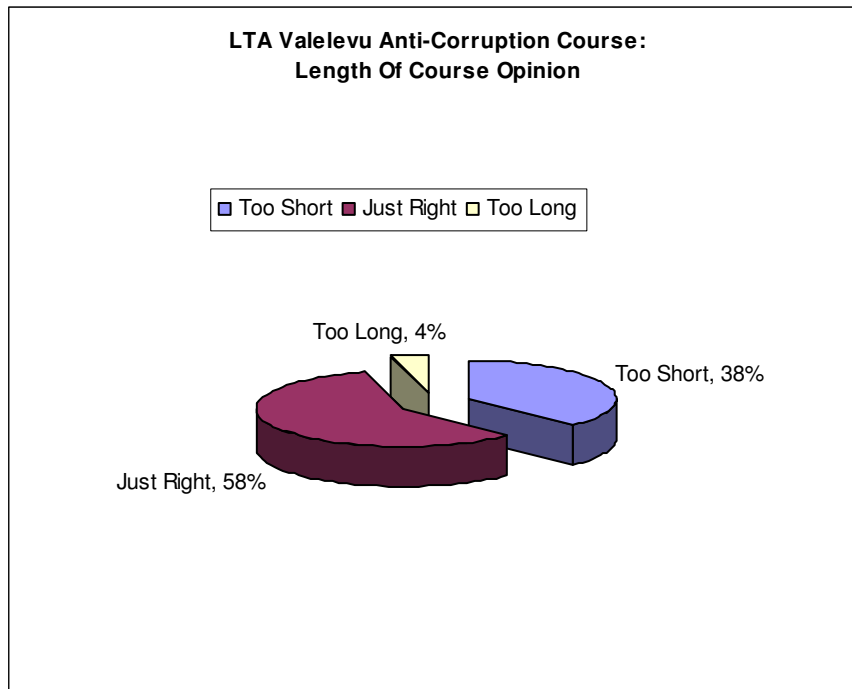

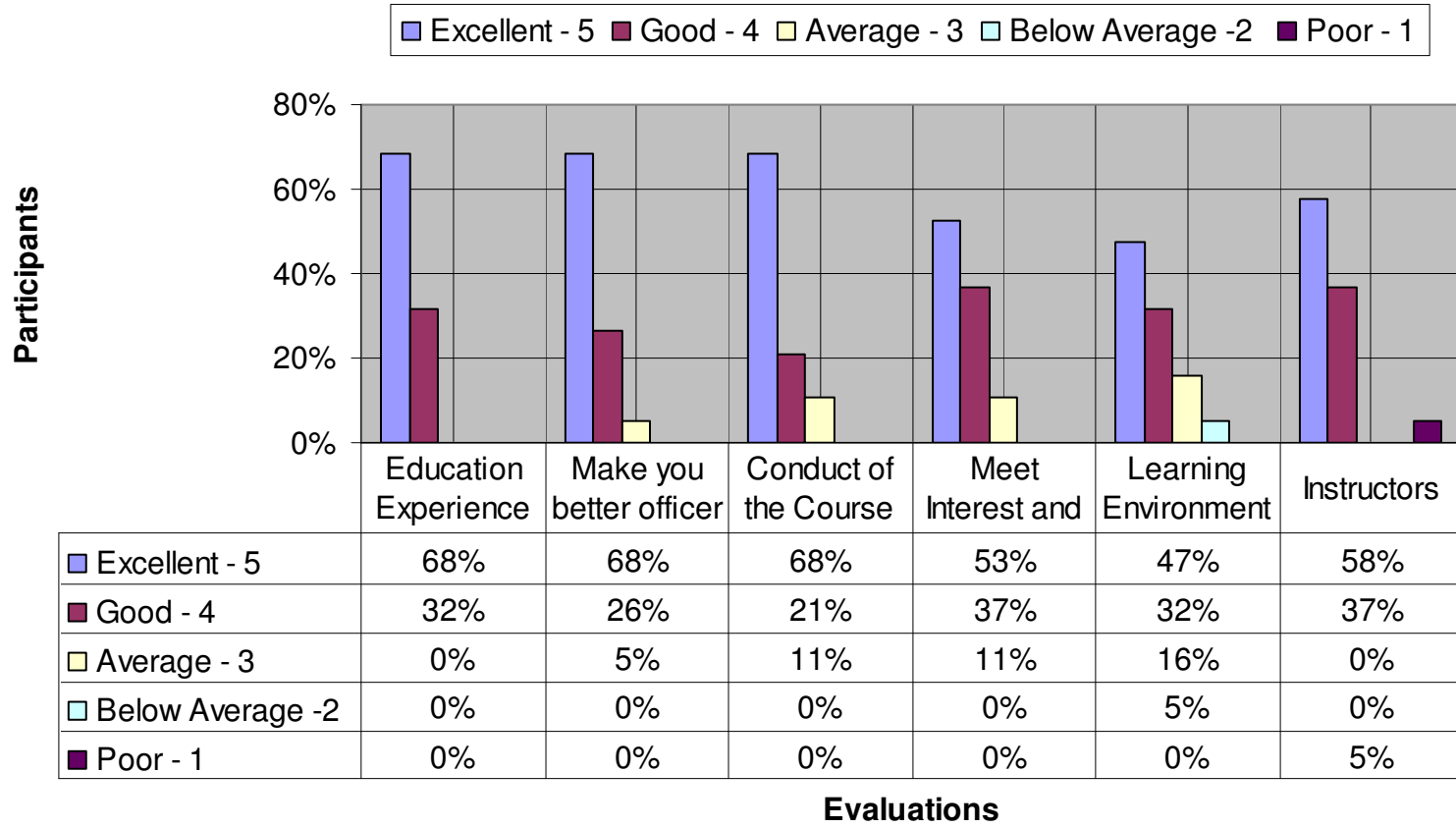
Comments were as follows:

12. Request the workshop to be repeated more often

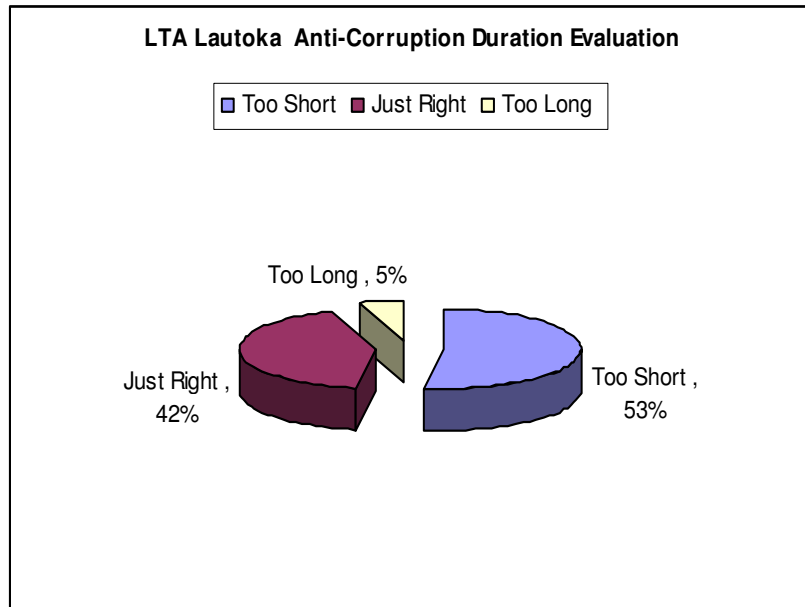

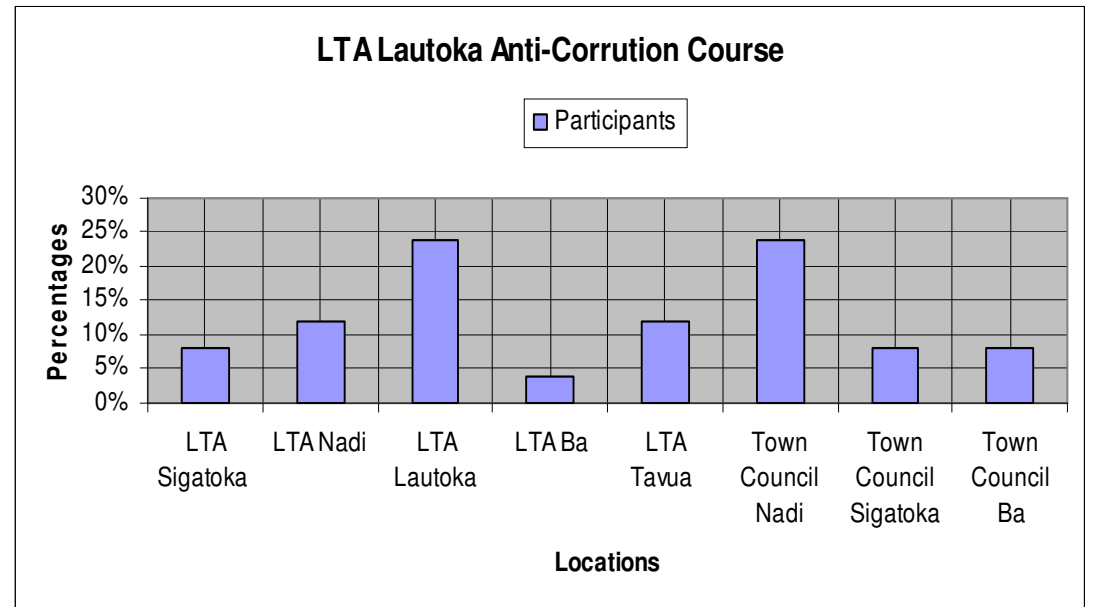

Lautoka Workshop – Participants



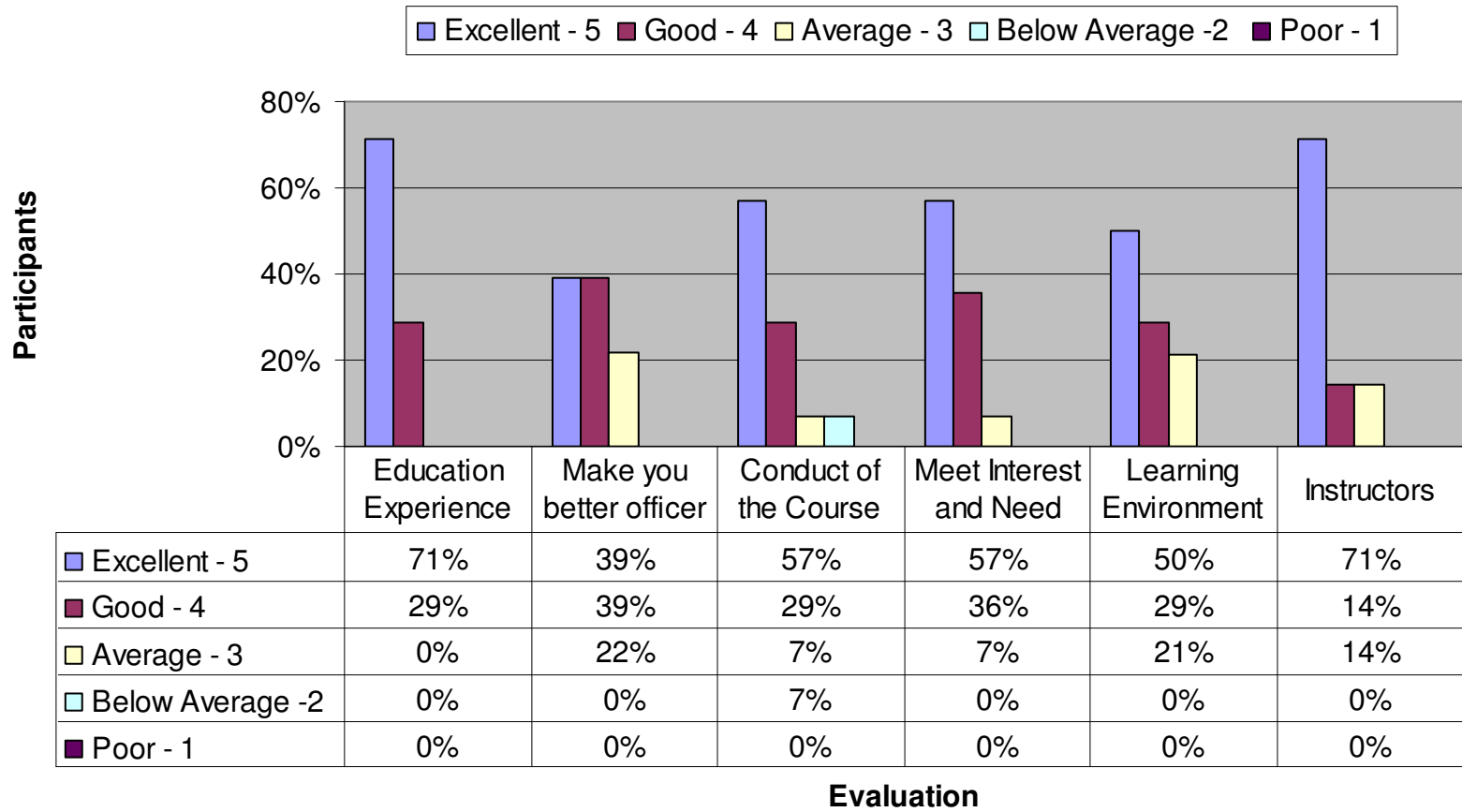
Comments were as follows:

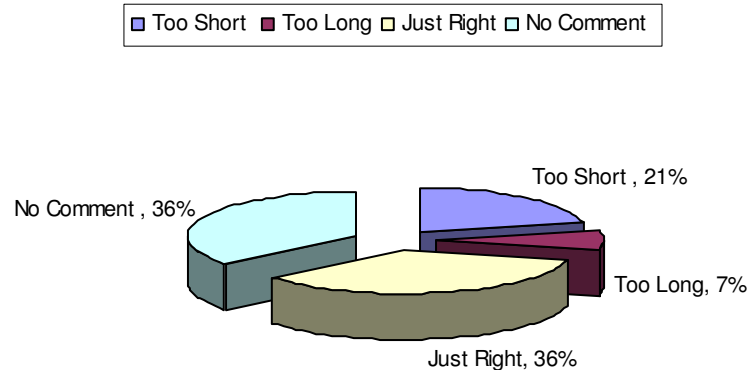

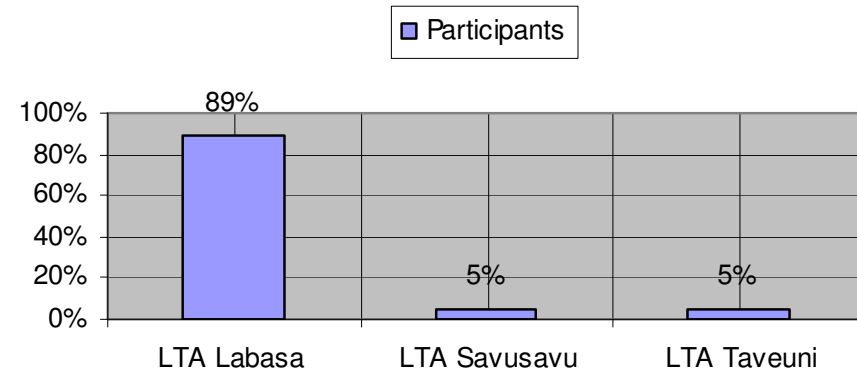
Labasa Workshop: Duration Evaluation
