## PRESS RELEASE ON AUDITOR GENERAL'S INVESTIGATION

---

Transparency International Fiji notes with appreciation the near completion of the Auditor General's investigation into the \$184,740 payout to the Commander of the RFMF and Interim Prime Minister for accumulated leave as reported in the public media. However, TI Fiji remains concerned that in the absence of Parliament there has been no alternative legislated means of exposing the Auditor General's report to the public as is an essential component of good and responsible governance. In this respect TI Fiji reiterates its call for Freedom of Information legislation as stipulated in the constitution.
